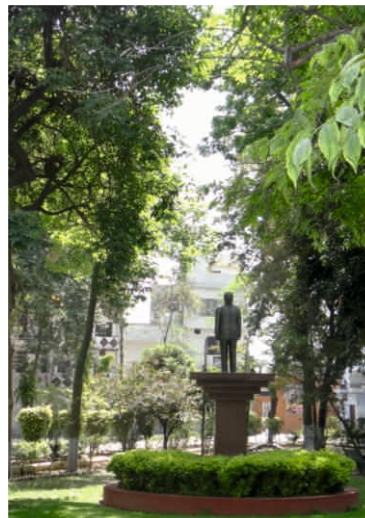

- i) Income Certificate of father
- j) Caste Certificate (For SC/BC Category)

(ii) One additional seat for Cancer Patients/Aids Patients/Thalassemia (with certificate as a proof from the National Medical Institute like PGI, AIIMS etc. in support of his/her claim).

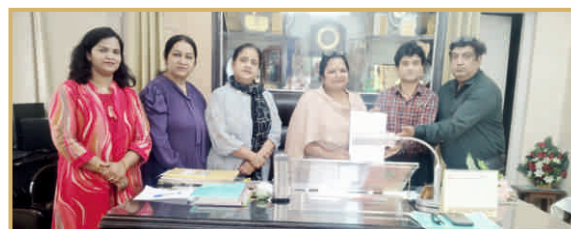

There will be Mid Semester exams before Semester examination. In addition to it, there will be monthly test in all subjects. It is compulsory for every student to appear in Mid-semester examination & monthly class tests because the eligibility to appear in the University Examination depends on the student's performance in these Examinations. **Only those students will be allowed to sit for the University Examination who have obtained at least 25% marks in the aggregate of Mid Semester Examinations. Those who remain absent in these Examinations will be strictly dealt with or may be detained.**

In case a student is sick and unable to take examination, she must submit an application along with Medical Certificate from a qualified doctor on the same date. **APPLICATION RECEIVED LATE WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.**

LECTURE ATTENDANCE

All students are expected to be regular and punctual. According to the University Regulations students with less than 75% attendance in each subject (Including tutorials, seminars, practicals and composition periods) will not be allowed to sit for the University Examination. Every student must attend her classes on all working days unless she is granted leave by the Principal. **If a student remains absent from her classes for a continuous period of SEVEN DAYS without leave, her name shall be struck off the college rolls. She will have to seek readmission with payment as per University Rules.**

Leave Rules:

1. Students must submit application for leave within three days of joining the college.
 - a) Leave must be applied on the prescribed form available from the office.
 - b) Leave application on plain paper will not be accepted.
2. Leave application must be duly signed by the father or the guardian of the student and also sanctioned by the tutor.
3. In case of illness, the application should be accompanied with a medical certificate.

B.A. II (Sem-III, Sem-IV) & B.A. III (Sem-V & Sem-VI) Eligibility: Students who have passed B.A. Previous Semester (Panjab University) are eligible for admission to B.A. Semester III, IV, V, & VI, on the condition that they will have to clear any deficient subjects (if any) within the permissible chances.

A student placed under compartment from any other university is not eligible for admission.
